# **Stainless Steel Finger Goniometers**

# User Manual

## **Intended Purpose**

A finger goniometer measures range-of-motion (ROM) of finger joints (metacarpophalangeal and interphalangeal) and other small joints including toes.



## Standard, 6 inch model

Standard 6" stainless steel finger goniometer has head with opposing 180° to 30° scales in 5° increments. Linear scale on arm measures in inches and centimeters.



## Deluxe, 6 inch model

Deluxe 6" stainless steel finger goniometer has extra-large head with opposing 180° to 0 scales in 5° increments. Linear scale on arm measures in inches and centimeters.



## Small, 3.5 inch model

Small 31/2" stainless steel finger agniometer has head with opposing 180° to 30° scales in 5° increments.

12-1010	SS finger goniometer, 6 inches
12-1011	SS deluxe finger goniometer, 6 inches
12-1015	SS finger goniometer, 3-1/2 inches

#### **Measurement Tolerance**

This device measures inches and centimeters with a tolerance of ±0.04 inches (±1 millimeter) and degrees with a tolerance of ±1 degree.

#### **Disposal Method**

Dispose of item in accordance with the local/ regional/national/international regulations.



#### WARNING:

- Clean and disinfect device before and after each patient use
- Verify measurement markings are clearly visible
- Ensure smooth operation of all moving parts
- Align device properly with anatomical landmarks
- Apply gentle pressure during measurements
- Stop if patient reports pain or discomfort
- Replace if accuracy becomes compromised
- Do not attempt to bend or modify the device
